18th July	Welshpool	Load 7.5tn lorry at store

	Caerwys	Set up camp site in Caerwys
18th-20th July	Caerwys	Site-sitting!
23rd-24th July	Caerwys	Take down site and load lorry
24th July	Caerwys-Welshpool	Drive lorry/tow cook trailer back to store
24th July	Welshpool	Offload lorry at store
3rd & 4th August	Welshpool plus	Drive lorry to and from Welshpool store/site & Cardiff/Luton
3rd-6th August	Welshpool	Set up marquees, tents etc at Welshpool site
18th-21st August	Welshpool	Take down site and return equipment to store
20th August	Welshpool plus	Drive lorry to Cardiff/Luton to return gear.
